



Donor Privacy Policy

Delaware Humane Association (DHA) respects the privacy of all its financial and in-kind donors, whether a donation is made online, by mail, or by any other method. When you make a donation, you may provide your name, contact information, credit card data, and other information. We protect your privacy in a variety of ways as described below.

Mailing Lists

Your name, address, and any other personal data you provide will be used only by DHA to keep you informed of our activities including our programs, special events, and funding needs via mail and email. DHA does not rent, sell, give away, or trade its donor lists or any information contained on those lists, in part or in full. Donor information is used by DHA for charitable purposes only as described above and will not be used by any entity outside of DHA. We will not send you communications on behalf of other entities. To review personal information collected, request changes, and/or to choose not to receive these communications, you may contact Daniel Condoluci-Smith, Director of Engagement.

Electronic Personal Records

Donor information is maintained in a secure database and only authorized personnel have access to this information. Information in the database is only used for appropriate business purposes.

DHA Vendors

DHA has vendors that assist with fundraising initiatives, processing, and research. We give vendors access to donor data. Our vendors are bound by strict confidentiality rules and are permitted to use donor data only to support DHA operations.

Authorized Release of Information

DHA may be legally required to disclose information on occasion. DHA complies with all applicable legal requirements and standards.
